The Drama department are pleased to inform all year 11 GCSE Drama students of a trip to the theatre in February 2020. Seeing this live production is a crucial part of the course and is a fantastic opportunity to see their set text performed to gain further understanding before sitting the written exam.

On Tuesday 4th February we are offering students the opportunity to see 'Blood Brothers' at Theatre Royal Brighton. **The trip will cost £40 which will include the coach travel to and from Brighton. The coach will leave the school at 3pm on Tuesday 4th February 2020 and will arrive back to school around midnight.**

There are 74 places available on the trip and we hope all GSCE acting and technical students come as this production is their set text for the written exam. Those who secure a place will be notified and a request will be made to make an online payment. **If your child would like a place on the trip, please complete the online consent which will be available on the Scopay website, www.scopay.com payment is not available yet. Please complete by Friday 6th December. By consenting to your child's attendance on this trip you are agreeing to pay the full amount requested. Payment value will show as zero until your place is confirmed.**
